Olmos Park restaurant Tribeca 212 under new management

The restaurant Tribeca 212 in Olmos Park has been taken over by a new management team.

Rudy Souberbielle and partners Nick Gutierrez and Emely Zuluaga have taken over ownership of the restaurant at 4331 McCullough Ave. Souberbielle has a long history working with restaurants in San Antonio, including Las Canarias, Le Reve, Little Italy, Francesca's at Sunset and, most recently, Zinc Bistro and Bar.

I don't just train my staff, I focus on educating them, and I've had a very loyal following of customers because I treat them like family and friends, which is what they've become," Souberbielle said in a statement.

Souberbielle's team, including Executive Chef David Yokuty, intends to transform Tribeca 212 to reflect the New York City neighborhood it's named after.

"We want to bring a slice of that urban, cosmopolitan feel to San Antonio as we evolve our little corner of the world," he said.
